"Improvement of the integration of disabled people in the labour market through vocational qualification by means of e-learning on the basis of a curriculum for multimedia design"

Across Europe, people with mobility or other disabilities often have inadequate access to vocational training if they are unable to participate permanently in face-to-face training. But it is precisely people from this target group who can benefit from e-learning. It enables them to acquire a vocational qualification and thus gain access to the labour market.

The Strategic Partnership "E-Design" is designing a modular course for vocational training of "Multimedia Design" in the form of e-learning. With this course, learners acquire a high-quality education that is in demand on the labour market without having to be constantly mobile.

The partners from Estonia, Germany and Austria first define the contents of the "e-design" curriculum. On this basis they then develop the e-learning modules for the training and an implementation concept. Afterwards, participants will be given the opportunity to learn the developed contents in the partner countries during the pilot phase. After this phase, internships can be completed in companies, which deepen the theoretical content learned.

In addition to improving access to employment, the motivation and self-confidence of people with disabilities or health impairments should also be increased. The applied methodology offers the possibility to learn independently of time and place. Thus it will benefit a broad target group.
